Note:

1. Prospective candidates MUST be absolutely careful while making inputs in the online form. Any mistake(s) that may compromise their merit score/category or any other relevant details, shall result in cancellation of application form.
2. If any candidate notices any mistake in his/her printed application form after online submission, he/she is advised to apply again with the correct details. Under no circumstances, the application fees will be reversed/waived.
3. **Candidates whose name shall feature in First or Subsequent Call List for Counselling, must remain present at the venue** as per timings indicated in this notice. Otherwise, they shall have no subsequent claim for getting admission, even if their name features in a lucrative position of the merit list.
4. During Counselling, all candidates must produce ***ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS such as Higher Secondary Marksheet, Proof of Age (Madhyamik Admit Card/Birth Certificate), SC/ST/OBC/PH Certificate,*** for verification.
5. **All provisionally admitted candidates MUST note that they need to login again to the College admission portal to pay the tuition/admission fees within the specific deadline. Otherwise, admission will be cancelled.**
6. College authority has the right to reject the provisional admission of any candidate on ground(s) of non-payment of fees, false declaration, counterfeit or dubious credentials, non-eligibility for a subject etc.
7. Candidates passing H.S examination from vocational stream conducted by the *West Bengal State Council of Technical & Vocational Education & Skill Development (WBSCTVE&SD)* or any other equivalent Board/Council are eligible for admission only in Programme/General courses (not in Honours).
8. If newly admitted students do take admission elsewhere, they must inform the College so that the seat can be offered to other deserving candidates.
9. If newly admitted students do not attend classes regularly, College authority may consider to cancel their admission and offer the seat for next counselling.
